

NAIC MEETING SITE SELECTION POLICY

Several factors impact the choice of location for NAIC national meetings. Site selection is limited to hotels/convention centers that can accommodate more than 2,000 attendees. In addition, the NAIC makes an effort to hold national meetings in each NAIC zone (Western, Midwestern, Northeastern, and Southeastern). Meeting sites are selected five years in advance enabling the NAIC to negotiate substantially reduced hotel room rates.
